

## Guide to the 2023 Subject Index

**Committee mandate:** The Standing Committee on Resource Stewardship is a legislative policy committee with a mandate related to the areas of affordability and utilities, energy and minerals, environment and protected areas, forestry and parks, Indigenous relations, municipal affairs, transportation and economic corridors, and Treasury Board and finance.

On December 5, 2023, the Personal Information Protection Act was referred to the Standing Committee on Resource Stewardship pursuant to Government Motion 9. In accordance with section 63(2) of the act the committee must submit its report to the Assembly within 18 months after beginning its review, and that report is to include any amendments recommended by the committee.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Standing Committee on Resource Stewardship, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. Interim indexes are unedited and are not considered official. Committee activities during the 31st Legislature, First Session (June 20, 2023 – ) are as follows.
