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Main Estimates 2024-2025

The main estimates (budget) for 2024-2025 were all considered in the legislative policy committees. Below is a list of ministries, the schedule of debate, and links to posted transcripts. At 3:30 p.m. on March 21 the Committee of Supply met to vote on the estimates.

Estimates debates were scheduled for three hours except for Executive Council, Transportation and Economic Corridors, Infrastructure, and Service Alberta and Red Tape Reduction, which were scheduled for two hours. The ministries of Education; Health; Seniors, Community and Social Services; and Treasury Board and Finance each had two meetings scheduled for a total of six hours' debate per ministry.
